This page contains all the essential info you need in order to have a fantastic time at Together. It's important that you read it, because we can't be held responsible for your air horn or water-cooled laser when it gets confiscated...

The gates will be open from midday on Friday 5th and music will commence from approximately 14.30pm. Music on Saturday and Sunday will start at midday. Amplified music will end around midnight each day which is when we move to the campfire and into the VideoDome for silent disco with awesome 360° visuals until the wee hours.

The campsite will close on Monday 8th and everyone will need to be off-site by midday.

Please note traffic on/off-site is limited to the hours of 8am – 10pm. No traffic, bar emergency and service vehicles are to enter the site between the hours of 10pm and 8am.

GREEN/LOCAL PLEDGE

We are privileged to have such an amazing site and surroundings to host the party in and we want to look after it. We will be working closely with the local council, our neighbours and emergency services to provide the best possible party for both the locals and the travelling partygoers.

We've tried to source local produce and utilise local services where possible (you can see this most especially in the selection of drinks at the Chapter One bar!).

All packaging and cups in the Awamu Tea Tent are compostable and to reduce the volume of paper cups used at the party, we also have a limited number of Together stainless steel pint cups (which support British jobs, skills and industry) and mugs available to purchase on arrival from the Awamu tea tent - use

them again and again to help reduce landfill... and take a lovely souvenir home with you!

We are working with a sustainable waste company and recycling and rubbish facilities will be provided on the campsite. We appreciate your support and commitment to reducing waste whilst enjoying the party. Please do not bring glass on to site and remember to take as much of your rubbish with you. Leave no trace!

KIDS

We welcome children and have lots going on for little people. Check the programme (on the right) and chalk boards at the Awamu Tea Tent to find out what is happening each day... and kids, don't forget your hat for the hat party!

Parents please note: children must be accompanied by an adult at all times on site. Please be aware that, although it is not part of the site we are using for the party there is a large pond within the site boundaries - please take note of its location on the map or ask a member of the team.

DISABLED ACCESS

Together welcomes all. Please note the party is taking place in 145 acres of rolling parkland and therefore the ground is uneven and can be tricky to navigate even when sober. There is a hard track that runs up to the main site from the car park, there will be an accessible toilet on site and we can reserve parking if you let us know in advance. We offer a carer ticket to attendees in receipt of Disability Living Allowance (DLA)/Personal Independence Payment (PIP).

TO HELP YOU START EVERY DAY FEELING REFRESHED

Hidden amongst the trees you'll find the rustic spa area with cosy changing area, hot showers, wood fired sauna and cold plunge (brrr!).

Reserve a massage treatment, sign up to a restorative yoga class or book a private session in the sauna here or at the Awamu Tea Tent.

PHONE CHARGING

Phone charging will be available at the Awamu tea tent for a small donation.

PETS

Because we are sharing our beautiful site with friendly Sheep and Deer no pets are allowed on the party site.

CASH

We advise bringing lots to spend at our very reasonably priced bars and food stalls, but there will be an opportunity to get some 'cash back' at certain times of day. Ask at the Awamu Tea Tent.

We will not be liable to party goers in any circumstances for any property damage or theft or personal belonging lefts in tents.

We have a no drugs policy and reserve the right to eject anyone suspected of taking illegal substances or infringement of this policy. Our eviction policy also includes the use of nitrous oxide and tagging.

AGE RESTRICTIONS

We welcome all ages to the festival. However, there are entry restrictions. Anyone 16 and under must be accompanied by a ticket holder over 18 years old at all times.

ID may be required upon entry to the event. Please bring your original documents as you won't be able to use a photocopied version. If you don't have any of these, or don't want to lose valuable documents onsite, we suggest that you apply for a PASS approved ID, some of which are free to get.

Please bring ID if you look under 21 years old and remember that legally there is no automatic right to be served alcohol. Service is always at the discretion of the licensee for whatever reason they decide, and the licensee is under no obligation to explain the reason.
